SIX TRAITS WRITING RUBRIC - TeacherPlanet

Writing is lifeless • No hint of the writer • Writing tends to be flat or stiff • Stereotypic, copied tone and voice • Voice may be inappropriate or non-existent • Writing may seem mechanical • Evident commitment to topic • Inconsistent or formulaic personality • Appropriate to audience and purpose • Writer behind the words comes
