from the mold Make sure that the soap is firm before you remove it 2 Cut your soap to the desired size 3 Place cut soap on a paper bag and let cure for 4-8 weeks With Castile soap, the cure time is 6 months 4 Soap is usable after two days, however, the lye is still active in the soap, so until the water is fully dissipated from the soap
