SECTION 3(1) "Murder in the first degree" means murder in the second degree as de-fined in ORS 163115 which is committed under, or accompanied by, any of the following cir-cumstances: (a) The defendant committed the murder pursuant to an agreement that the defendant receive money or other thing of value for committing the murder
