Voice-over Archival footage

Interviews on opposing sides of an issue may be shown to give the viewer comprehensive information about a topic Montage A montage sequence conveys ideas visually by putting them in a specific order in the film Narrative montages involve the planning of sequence of shots used to indicate changes in time and place within a film

the documentary, record or film interviews, etc Credits: You must also include credits at the end of the documentary and these credits will count towards the time limit Self Run: A History Day documentary must also be self-run, which means that there is no live narration or commentary during the documentary
