Major Functions of the GI Tract Six Processes of the GI Tract

Digestive Activities: Large Intestine • 12-14 hour journey • Bacteria in colon metabolize waste and produce gases (methane and hydrogen sulfide) • Some bacteria make vitamin K and B vitamins • Vitamins, water and some ions absorbed here • Feces is delivered to rectum Peristalsis and mass movements occur in the large intestine
