### ACTIVE AND PASSIVE TENSES CHART

Passive: Past Continuous The bathroom was being cleaned by me The bedroom was being cleaned by them The kitchen and patio were being cleaned by Susan PRESENT PERFECT, PAST PERFECT and FUTURE PERFECT Passive form: have/has been + past participle had been + past participle

Active: Present Perfect I have mailed the gift Jack has mailed the gifts
