LibertyTown Arts Workshop Pottery Studio Guidelines

Studio potters may buy clay through the front desk at the discounted rate of \$30 per 25 lbs Outside clay must be approved by the pottery manager LibertyTown will not fire higher than cone 6 and may approve lower-fired clays on an individual basis Outside glazes, underglazes, and slips must be approved by the pottery manager prior to use

Make small balls of clay and press them into the clay at the intersections of the grid (figure 4) This pushes back in and emphasizes the alteration Trim excess clay from the bottom Set aside and allow it to become leather hard Throw a 1-inch-thick disk and compress it, but end the compression about $\frac{3}{4}$ inches from the edge (figure 5)
