Medical Speech & Swallowing Disorders Voice Therapy Symptomatic voice therapy is an approach to work directly on single voice components, such as pitch, loudness, resonance, or respiration Physiologic and holistic voice therapy is an approach to balance the three subsystems of voice production at once

Your voice remains strongest and most efficient when properly exercised Your breathing is the power behind your voice The air that you exhale causes the vocal folds to vibrate, which produces your voice

Voice Quality

What is voice quality? Voice quality can refer to any of the suprasegmental properties of speech that result from how your vocal apparatus is configured - Example: nasality Usually, though, we use "voice quality" to refer specifically to the properties of speech affected by stuff inside your larynx

SilentVoice: Unnoticeable Voice Input by Ingressive Speech

By using ingressive speech, ultra-small utterances can be captured with an ultra-closely placed microphone, and we can use voice input not only in quiet rooms but also noisy public spaces without annoying other people The following sections describe the details of our ingressive speech-based voice input mechanism (named SilentVoice)
