90% of all the words in texts consists of less than 3% of all the words in English The bulk of English vocabulary (ie, the "other 97%") or the extended vocabulary is made up of approximately 290,000 words (Simpson & Weiner, 2009) In complex texts, the extended vocabulary typically accounts for 7-10% of the words
