2 By means of -- Most often, just "by" will serve and save words Case -- Can be ambiguous, misleading, or ludicrous because of different connotations; eg, "In the case of Scotch whiskey," Case also is a frequent offender in padded, drawn-out sentences For "in this case," try "in this instance" Commas and punctuation - Not precisely a word ...

Kindergarten & First Grade

Many children experience "word finding" problems This makes it difficult to think of nouns and verbs Encourage them to take time and to think of a real word instead of "filler" words (thingy, stuff) Prompts that may be useful: gesture, beginning sound, multiple choice
