complete in itself typically containing a subject and predicate conveying a statement question exclamation or command and consisting of a main clause and sometimes one or more subordinate clauses oxford dictionary the four types of sentence find examples of how to use any word or phrase in a sentence with our powerful sentence generator a sentence contains a subject that is only given once smith he obtained his degree a sentence contains a verb or a verb phrase he obtained his degree a sentence follows subject verb object word order he subject obtained verb his degree object a sentence must have a complete idea that stands alone in traditional english grammar a predicate is made up of a verb or verb phrase a verb and any objects or modifiers relating to it while the subject consists of a noun pronoun or a phrase containing either a sentence whether short or long must express a complete idea and a complete sentence must consist of at least one independent clause that is a subject and there are many types of sentences all with different structures and complexities in its most basic form a sentence is made up of a subject and predicate which is the verb and the words that follow but no matter how simple or complex a sentence consists of words words in a sentence are what make it come alive and make sense aug 12 2022 simple sentences are any sentence with only one independent clause any sentence with more than one clause including complex sentences cannot be simple sentences interestingly you can sometimes combine two simple sentences to create one complex sentence as long as you add a subordinate conjunction simple sentences troy ate sentence definition a grammatical unit of one or more words that expresses an independent statement question request command exclamation etc and that typically has a subject as well as a predicate as in john is here or is john here in print or writing a sentence typically begins with a capital letter and ends with
