Judaism espoused by the Rabbanites has been the mainstream form of Judaism since the 6th century CE after the codification of the Babylonian Talmud. Rabbinic Judaism has its roots in Pharisaic Judaism and is based on the belief that Moses at Mount Sinai received both the written Torah (Torah She Be Khetav) and the oral tradition (Torah She Be Peh). Rabbinic Judaism is the normative form of Judaism that developed after the fall of the Temple of Jerusalem in 70 AD. It originated in the work of the Pharisaic rabbis, based on the legal and commentative literature in the Talmud, and it set up a mode of worship and a life discipline that were to be practiced by Jews worldwide down to modern times. Rabbinic, secular, humanistic rabbis are spiritual leaders and philosophic and cultural mentors for secular humanistic Jews. They serve as teachers, counselors, pastors, ceremonialists, celebrants, and ceremonial guides and experts in Judaism. Since 1992, the IISHJ Rabbinic Program has trained and ordained the future of secular humanistic Judaism.
